A setup for handling generic model attachments

About Bambu Attachments

This package contains a simple set of models and admin helper classes that allow you to add media attachments to any model.

About Bambu Tools 2.0

This is part of a toolset called Bambu Tools. It's being moved from a namespace of `bambu` to its own 'root-level' package, along with all the other tools in the set. If you're upgrading from a version prior to 2.0, please make sure to update your code to use `bambu_attachments` rather than `bambu.attachments`.

Installation

Install the package via Pip:

```
pip install bambu-api
```

Add it to your `INSTALLED_APPS` list:

```
INSTALLED_APPS = (  
    ...  
    'bambu_attachments'  
)
```

Run `manage.py syncdb` or `manage.py migrate` to setup the database tables.

5.1 Settings

ATTACHMENTS_MIMETYPES The type of approved MIME types that can be uploaded

ATTACHMENT_WIDTH The default width to embed images and video

6.1 Template tags

`bambu_attachments.templatetags.attachments.attachments` (*value*, *obj*, *width=640*)

Parse the copy inside *value* and look for shortcodes in this format:

```
<p>Here's an attachment</p>
<p>[attachment 1]</p>
```

Replace the shortcode with a full image, video or audio element, or download link

Parameters

- **obj** – The object against which attachments are saved
- **width** – The width of images or audio/video tags (defaults to the `ATTACHMENT_WIDTH SETTING`)

6.2 Models

`class bambu_attachments.models.Attachment` (**args*, ***kwargs*)

`Attachment(id, file, size, mimetype, title, description, featured, saved, content_type_id, object_id)`

description = None

A full description of the attachment

featured = None

Set to `True` when the attachment should be considered that object's featured attachment or thumbnail

mimetype = None

The file MIME type

size = None

File size (in bytes)

title = None

The attachment title (useful for generating an `alt` attribute)
