CHAPTER 2

Postgresql

Postgresql from source.

- Postgresql from official git VCS.
- Adjustable version by updating `git checkout` tag.
- Support for python, tcl, perl.
- Support for `init.d` service.
- Pure Dockerfile, no external shell scripts.

This Dockerfile compiles postgres from git and sets up a service with the username and password `docker` and `docker`.

Currently it uses the release 9.3.1.

The version can be adjusted by modifying the `git checkout REL9_3_1` in the Dockerfile.

2.1 Building and debugging

sudo docker build -t="postgresql" .
```
