## Development Notes

---

Below are some notes on how to get your development environment setup and how to get ready to contribute code.

### 1.1 Setting up your development environment

Install requirements:

- VirtualBox - <https://www.virtualbox.org>
- Vagrant - <http://www.vagrantup.com>

Clone the repo:

```
$ git clone https://github.com/hamster-dev/hamster-core
```

Startup and provision the development VM:

```
$ cd hamster-core  
$ vagrant up
```

Assuming that went well, you can now login to the VM:

```
$ vagrant ssh
```

Initial setup of the virtualenv and site:

```
$ mkvirtualenv hamster  
$ cd /vagrant  
$ pip install -Ur hamster/requirements.pip  
$ python manage.py syncdb --migrate
```

... and start up the site:

```
$ python manage.py runserver 0.0.0.0:8000
```

You should see it running at <http://localhost:9000>
