```

- `--no_docs`: Omit docs directory
- `--no_src`: Omit src directory
- `--no_gitignore`: Omit gitignore
- `--no_ci`: Omit .travis.yml
- `--no_pypirc`: Omit .pypirc
- `--no_license`: Omit license
- `--no_manifest`: Omit MANIFEST.in
- `--no_readme`: Omit README.rst
- `--no_setup`: Omit setup.py
- `--no_contributing`: Omit CONTRIBUTING
- `--no_changelog`: Omit CHANGELOG.rst
- `--no_authors`: Omit AUTHORS
- `--no_vagrantfile`: Omit Vagrantfile
- `--no_requirements`: Omit requirements.txt
- `--no_berksfile`: Omit Berksfile
- `--no_coveragerc`: Omit .coveragerc
