Installation

1.1 Clone the repo

```
git clone git://github.com/reinbach/tutorus.git
```

1.2 Create VirtualEnv

```
mkvirtualenv tutorus
```

1.3 Install requirements

```
pip install -r requirements.txt
```

1.4 Configure settings

Configure your settings `settings/<env>.py` and then create symlink back to `<env>.py` called `currentenv.py`

```
ln -s settings/prod.py settings/currentenv.py
```

1.5 Sync Database

```
python manage.py syncdb
```

1.6 Run migrations

```
python manage.py migrate
```

1.7 Collect Static Media

```
python manage.py collectstatic
```

1.8 Start Server

Start server <dev mode>

```
python manage.py collectstatic
```

1.9 Running the unit tests

```
./manage test --settings=settings.test
```

1.10 Making the Docs

```
cd docs make html
```
